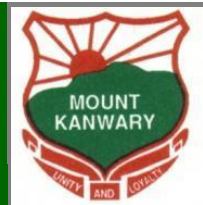

Celebrating the Safer Internet Day 2018 (SID) theme of "Create, connect and share respect:

A better internet starts with you" this session is a call to action for everyone to join in and engage with others in a more respectful way online and offline.

The presentation will assist students to:

- identify the benefits of belonging to an online community
- identify how valuing and respecting diversity online and offline contributes to the well-being of a community
- identify strategies for creating a respectful and inclusive online and offline school community

With the help of classroom teachers, the presentation will feature polling and interactive questions.

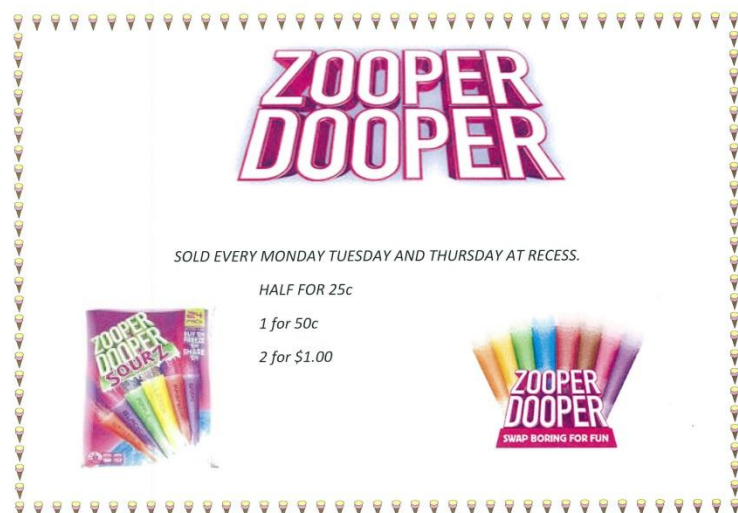

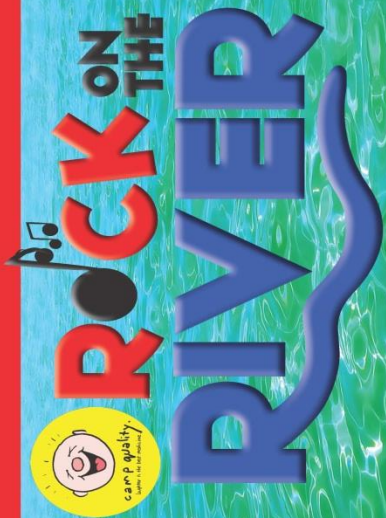
