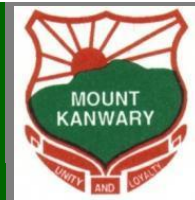

On Wednesday our students visited our Grandfriends at Opal Nursing Home at Raymond Terrace. We enjoyed singing, playing games and



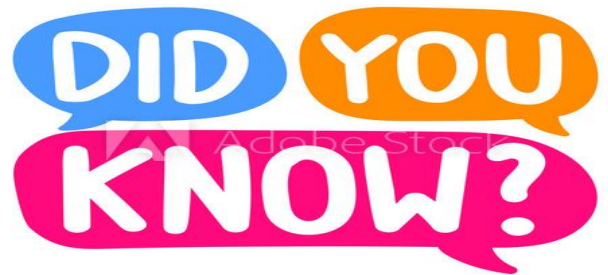
