Now is a great time to renew your entertainment book membership with last year's membership running out on 30 June 2019. Entertainment books are available to be purchased now for 2019/2020.

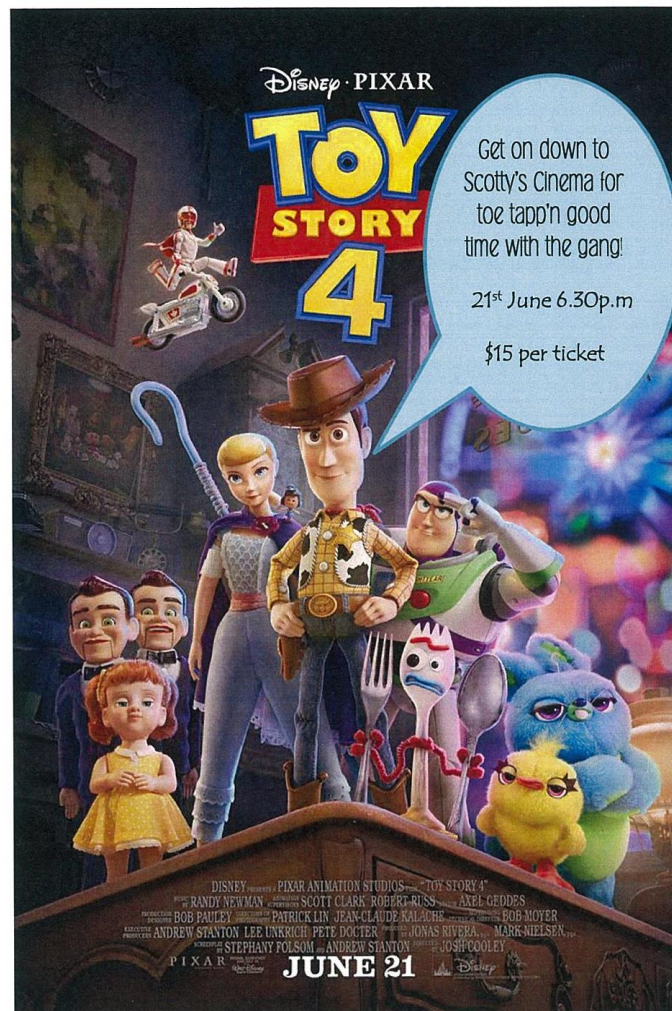
